The board has been working closely with Joel Den Han over the summer, and updates will be announced.

As we move into Fall 2025, the Board and Trustees of Westminster United Church are working closely with our congregation's designated representatives, and with Chinook Winds Region, to develop plans for the future of the church and manse property. We have retained expert brokerage assistance from Avison Young, and we have expanded our relationship on a short term basis with Little Own Learning Centre Inc. for their summer programming. All current discussions are subject to ongoing review from both Avison Young and Chinook Winds Region.

Although no long-term transaction is under consideration at this time, we are working on plans for future ownership and operation of the Westminster United Church properties. All of these are subject to a legally-enforceable Confidentiality Agreement as well as to the terms of our Brokerage

Agreement. Once any proposals are negotiated, we are required to bring them back to the congregation and to Chinook Winds Region for further review and approval. Until Chinook Winds Region offers official approval, no long-term changes will occur for our church property.
